



## WORLD BOUNDARIES AND ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATION

*Bearing in mind the upcoming 5th Constituent Assembly,  
Moving towards the First Operational Stage outlined in the Earth Constitution,  
And with the impetus of the 16th Session of the Provisional World Parliament (PWP)  
held in December 2025 in Pondicherry, India, each Administration, Committee, and  
Commission is framed within the work plan of the Provisional World Parliament*

---

### 1. Legal basis and role

The World Boundaries and Elections Administration is established with the approval of the Provisional World Parliament in accordance with the World Constitution and World Laws WLA73, WLA75 and WLA76, adopted during the 16th Session of the Provisional World Parliament in Pondicherry, India (December 2025).

This Administration is activated with the powers described in article 8.3 of the World Constitution of the Earth Federation. (WLA73 in its article 1).

The following World Legislative Acts have been repealed: Act 29 (2004/2013) World Boundaries and Elections Administration and Provisions for the World People's Assembly; Act 67 (2015) Call for a Direct People's Referendum on the Earth Constitution; and Law 72 (2021) World District Rules.

Article 19 of the World Constitution stipulated the operation of a World Electoral Commission (WEC) to "prepare a provisional global map of Administrative Electoral Districts and Regions," to be revised during the first or second operational stages of the World Government, and to prepare and implement plans for the election of members of the World Parliament for the House of Peoples and the House of Councillors. From now on, this World Electoral Commission (WEC) has become the World Boundaries and Election Administration (WBA), which is considered operational.

## 2. Status and nature

2.1. The Boundaries and Elections Administration will promote the Earth Constitution, elections, and the ratification process in coordination with the Ratification Commission, also activated at the 16th Session of the Provisional World Parliament in December 2025.

2.2. This Administration operates in coordination with the Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat, the Ratification Commission, and the Provisional World Parliament.

## 3. Mission and objectives

The Boundaries and Elections Administration shall:

- Delineate World Electoral Districts with the active participation of delegates and the Ratification Commission;
  - Assign each registered person a Unique Universal Identification Number (NUI), preferably automatically generated in coordination with the Digital Strategy Commission;
  - Provide a register of eligible voters for each delineated District. The Register of World Citizens will be centralized globally;
  - Integrate into a single register all eligible candidates for each office who have expressed in writing their desire to run for any of the positions within the Electoral District;
  - Establish a secure online voting system in which all registered individuals can participate with the Digital Strategy Commission help;
  - Provide informational content for the development of promotional materials;
  - Advise and support members of the Promoter Team and the Standing Electoral Committee in the electoral processes.

## 4. Scope of competence and responsibilities

### 4.1. **Global Strategic Coordination**

- Demarcation of World Electoral Districts;
- Make periodic adjustments according to demographic changes and conduct a census every five years;
- Improve common strategies with the Ratification Commission to facilitate the creation of the Districts.

#### **4.2. Procedures for Citizenship and Organizational Participation**

- Monitoring of citizens registered in the Global Voter Database and the Universal Identification System for participation in elections and preparing voter's information booklets on candidates for elections;
- Organizations of any kind wishing to participate in referendum and election processes in the Electoral Districts must comply with the regulations of article IV.2 of World Law WLA76;
- World Law WLA76 promotes the use of information and communication technologies at all levels to create a stronger global democratic process, as per article IV.8. In this regard, this Administration will seek guidance from the Digital Strategy Commission.

#### **4.3. Nomination and Election of Members to the World Parliament**

- The Boundaries and Elections Administration will plan the details of the nomination and election of Parliament delegates to the House of Peoples and the House of Councillors, in accordance with article IV.3 of World Law WLA76;
- This Administration may adjust the proposed electoral procedures and, after review, will submit the plans to Parliament.

#### **4.4. Conducting Elections to Houses of Peoples and Counsellors**

(not to the House of Nations)

- The Boundaries and Elections Administration will plan the details of the nomination and election to the House of Peoples and the House of Councillors, in accordance with article IV.3 of World Law WLA76;
- Supervision of the entire electoral process in accordance with Article IV.4 of World Law WLA76 and preparation voter's information booklets on candidates for elections.

#### **4.5. Legislative Initiatives and Referendums**

- Initiatives must conform to the basic guidelines for professional legislative drafting adopted by Parliament (article IV.6, WLA76);
- To define the rules for Referendums and Plebiscites (article IV.7, WLA76), as during the interim stage of World Government, Parliament may hold referendums too.

### **5. Presidency**

5.1. The person responsible for the Boundaries and Elections Administration was elected by the Provisional World Parliament at its 16th Session held in December 2025.

5.2. The person responsible must:

- Convene the working sessions of this Administration;
  - Coordinate with the Ratification Commission;
  - Submit periodic reports to the Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat, and/or the World Parliament.

## 6. Composition and experience

6.1. Members and collaborators who voluntarily join this Commission will be accepted by the Chairperson, if there are no objections.

The volunteer members of this Commission are self-organized and independent individuals committed to the establishment of a "Democratic Federation of the Earth."

6.2. The experience of these members may include:

- Knowledge of Constitutional and International Law;
  - Studies in Geographic Information Systems;
  - Historical, demographic, sociopolitical, and cultural knowledge of populations and regions.

## 7. Coordination and cooperation

This Commission collaborates especially with:

- The Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat, and the Provisional World Parliament;
  - The Ratification Commission;
  - The Judicial and Electoral bodies;
  - The Press Office.

## 8. Entry into force

This document will come into effect in February 2026 following its approval by its own Administration, the Presidium, and the Permanent Secretariat. It will remain valid until further update.
