



GLOBAL COUNCIL FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF CONSCIOUSNESS

*Bearing in mind the upcoming 5th Constituent Assembly,
Moving towards the First Operational Stage outlined in the Earth Constitution,
And with the impetus of the 16th Session of the Provisional World Parliament (PWP) held
in December 2025 in Pondicherry, India, each Administration, Committee, and
Commission is framed within the work plan of the Provisional World Parliament.*

1. Legal basis and role

The Global Council for the Development of Consciousness was endorsed by the Provisional World Parliament at its 16th Session in December 2025, and approved as a World Legislative Act (WLA 80).

This Council, sponsored by Leopoldo Cook, is committed to promoting the development of higher levels of consciousness as a fundamental condition for humanity's peace, planetary governance, sustainability, and the ethical use of power and technology.

2. Status and nature

2.1. The Council is a strategic, consultative and research-oriented body.

2.2. It operates in coordination with the Presidium and the Provisional World Parliament.

3. Mission and vision:

- To support the evolution of human consciousness from egocentric and ethnocentric stages to a Cosmocentric Consciousness, since Consciousness is the common basis from which all Manifestation arises;
 - Work to integrate ethical, spiritual, philosophical and scientific perspectives into planetary governance; countering the massive manipulation, dehumanization and technocratic domination.

4. The Council's scope of competences includes:

4.1 Research and integration of knowledge

- Study of consciousness from scientific, philosophical, cultural and spiritual perspectives. This Council affirms that sustainable planetary governance is not possible without a parallel evolution of Consciousness;
- Integration of diverse traditions and contemporary research;
- Support for interdisciplinary, public, artistic, and cultural dialogue.

4.2 Policy Advisory Role

- Advice on the ethical implications of legislation, technology and governance;
- Assessment of social impacts on human development and mental health.

4.3 Education and public awareness

- Promotion of Education for the development of Consciousness, fostering cultural transformation and spiritual literacy.

5. Roles and responsibilities:

- To prepare and present research studies, policy reports, activity reports, and conceptual contributions, as well as ethical assessments;
 - To advise the Provisional World Parliament and its bodies;
 - To organize forums, dialogues and educational initiatives;
 - To support global initiatives that foster peace and inner development.

6. Presidency

6.1. The person responsible for this Council is elected or confirmed by the Presidium and/or the Provisional World Parliament.

6.2. The person responsible for this Council:

- Will agree on the Council's Strategy with the members of the working group.
 - Exercises representation before Parliament and other bodies.

7. Composition and experience:

7.1. The Council is composed of members and collaborators who join freely and are accepted by the responsible person if there are no objections.

7.2. The experience may include, among other contents:

- Philosophy and Ethics; Psychology and Neuroscience; knowledge of spiritual traditions; field of Education and diverse cultural areas.

8. Coordination and cooperation

The Council cooperates in particular with:

- The Education and the Youth Committees;
 - The Commission for Peace and Disarmament.

9. Civilizational role

The Global Council for the Development of Consciousness contributes to a civilizational shift towards Unity, responsibility and planetary citizenship.

10. Entry into force

This document enters into force in April 2026 after its approval by the person responsible for this Council, the Presidium and the Permanent Secretary. It will be valid until further update.
