



COMMISSION TO JOIN FORCES WITH WORLD FEDERALIST ORGANIZATIONS

*Bearing in mind the upcoming 5th Constituent Assembly,
Moving towards the First Operational Stage outlined in the Earth Constitution,
And with the impetus of the 16th Session of the Provisional World Parliament (PWP) held
in December 2025 in Pondicherry, India, each Administration, Committee, and
Commission is framed within the work plan of the Provisional World Parliament*

1. Legal basis and role

The Commission to Join Forces with Federalist Organizations is created with the approval of the Provisional World Parliament in accordance with the World Constitution and World Law (WLA75) adopted during the 16th Session of the PWP in Pondicherry, India (December 2025).

This Commission is tasked with engaging with federalist organizations worldwide to promoting respect for the World Constitution and International Law.

2. Status and nature

2.1. This Commission is a strategic body for collaboration among democratic federalist organizations.

2.2. It contributes with its proposals and initiatives to fostering shared activities based on a common ideology among federalist organizations.

2.3. This Commission operates in coordination with the Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat and the Provisional World Parliament. It takes into consideration the organizations dedicated to promoting the "World Campaign for Democracy" (WCD) launched in the spring of 2024 by the World Constitution Association and the Provisional World Parliament in coordination with the Earth Constitution Institute (ECI).

3. Mission and objectives

The mission of this Commission focuses on acting as a central hub for the harmonization and promotion of content and actions, enabling federalist organizations to work with an integrated vision that they can sustain in the long term.

Among its main objectives are:

- To integrate and coordinate the activities of diverse federalist organizations based on a common strategy, promoting collaboration for federal strengthening;
 - To enhance local, regional, and global cooperation among organizations, as well as the efficiency in managing their policies and concrete actions;
 - This Commission plays a central role in attracting federalist organizations to participate in the 5th World Constituent Assembly and in supporting the ratification of the Earth Constitution.

4. Scope of competence

The scope of the Commission includes:

4.1 Strategic Coordination

- Aligning the actions of different organizations;
- Working towards shared federal objectives;
- Improving common strategies by fostering discussion in study forums.

4.2 Strengthening Federalism

- Consolidating the political and social institutions of the various federalist organizations;
- Promoting mutual respect for the ideologies of the different organizations, encouraging a convergence towards a common vision.

4.3 Local, Regional, and Global Integration

- Fostering joint work and cooperation, encouraging territorial development at the local, regional, and global levels;
 - Acting with the greatest possible unity to defend shared interests and ensure cohesion among all organizations.

5. Functions and responsibilities

The Commission shall:

- Prepare periodic reports on the actions taken and submit them to the Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat, and the Provisional World Parliament;
 - Represent the Provisional World Parliament in federalist forums;
 - Report periodically to Committees, Commissions, and Administrations on actions that may affect them;
 - Maintain a register of federalist organizations worldwide.

6. Presidency

6.1. The Chairperson for the Commission to Join Forces with Federalist Organizations was elected by the Provisional World Parliament at its 16th Session held in December 2025.

6.2. The responsible person must:

- Convene the Commission's working sessions;
 - Reach agreements with internal collaborators and external organizations;
 - Lead the implementation process of the agreed-upon actions.

7. Composition and experience

7.1. Members and collaborators who voluntarily join this Commission will be accepted by the Chairperson, if there are no objections.

The volunteer members of this Commission are self-organized and independent individuals committed to the establishment of a "Democratic Federation of the Earth," willing to use the World Constitution as a guide for their study.

7.2. The experience of these members may include:

- Knowledge of Constitutional and International Law;
 - Knowledge of or studies on comparative governance systems;
 - Experience in organizations with a federal structure;
 - Competence in mediating between different organizations, ensuring respect and coherence among them.

8. Coordination and cooperation

This Commission collaborates especially with:

- The Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat, and the Provisional World Parliament;
 - The Ratification Commission;
 - The judicial and electoral bodies;
 - The Press Office.

9. Entry into force

This document will come into effect in February 2026 following its approval by the own Commission, the Presidium, and the Permanent Secretariat.

It will remain valid until further update.
