



RATIFICATION COMMISSION OF THE WORLD CONSTITUTION FOR THE EARTH FEDERATION

*Bearing in mind the upcoming 5th Constituent Assembly,
Moving towards the First Operational Stage outlined in the Earth Constitution,
And with the impetus of the 16th Session of the Provisional World Parliament (PWP)
held in December 2025 in Pondicherry, India, each Administration, Committee, and
Commission is framed within the work plan of the Provisional World Parliament*

1. Legal basis and role

The Ratification Commission is created with the approval of the Provisional World Parliament in accordance with the World Constitution and World Laws Acts WLA75 and WLA76 adopted during the 16th Session of the Provisional World Parliament in Pondicherry, India, December 2025.

This Commission is activated under World Law Act (WLA75, Article 1.5), in relation to Article 19 of the World Constitution of the Earth Federation.

2. Status and nature

2.1. This Commission is a strategic body, but it does not exercise direct executive power. It works in coordination with the Administration of Boundaries and Elections.

2.2. Members of all Administrations, Committees and Commissions, as well as, citizens registered in the Global Voter Database, participate across all departments in the ratification process of the World Constitution.

2.3. This Commission operates under the supervision of the Presidium, the Provisional World Parliament and the Permanent Secretariat.

3. Mission and objectives

The main mission of this Commission is the dissemination of the World Constitution to ensure its understanding by citizens, organizations, and nations, proposing its ratification.

The following are also essential objectives of this Commission:

- To create an ad hoc Delegation to prepare and propose to the Nations the activation of Article 109 of Chapter XVIII "Reforms" of the Charter of the United Nations to convene a General Conference of UN Members for the purpose of revising the Charter according to Article 109, paragraph 1, or alternatively and preferably, using paragraph 3, which states that *"if such a Conference has not been held before the tenth annual meeting of the General Assembly (the Conference referred to in paragraph 1 has not been held), it may be held if so decided by a majority of the members of the General Assembly and any seven members of the Security Council"*;
 - Collaborate with the Legislative Review Commission for the Convening of the 5th Constituent Assembly.

4. Scope of competence and responsibilities

4.1. Strategic Coordination

- Collaborate closely with the Administration of Boundaries and Elections on the demarcation of World Electoral Districts with the active participation of delegates.
- Alert the Administration mentioned on demographic changes;
- Improve joint strategies with the Administration of Boundaries and Elections to facilitate the creation of Districts.

4.2. Procedures for disseminating the World Constitution

- Manage the call to nations to ratify the World Constitution;
- Make known the World Constitution in institutes, universities, professional associations, and other areas to encourage its ratification;
- Foster public dialogue in all spheres;
- Design media strategies: social networks, radio, TV channels, newspapers, etc.

4.3. Other competences

- Collaborate with the Legislative Review Commission to select the provisional location of the Primary World Capital (Article 15.3.5 of the World Constitution);
- Propose new global legislative laws if relevant;

- Promote the use of Information Technologies in accordance with Article IV.8 of WLA76. This Commission will request guidance from the Digital Strategy Commission to create a technology working group.

5. Presidency

5.1. The person responsible for the Ratification Commission was elected by the Provisional World Parliament at its 16th Session held in December 2025 and must:

- Convene the working sessions of this Commission;
 - Support the ad hoc Delegation for the activation of Article 109, paragraph 3 of the Charter of the United Nations;
 - Submit periodic reports to the Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat, and/or the World Provisional Parliament.

6. Composition and experience

6.1. Members and collaborators who voluntarily join this Commission will be accepted by the person in charge if there are no objections.

The volunteer members of this Commission are self-organized and independent individuals committed to the establishment of a "Democratic Earth Federation."

6.2. The experience of these members may include:

- Knowledge of Constitutional and International Law;
 - Studies in Geographic Information Systems;
 - Historical, demographic, sociopolitical, and cultural knowledge of populations and regions.

7. Coordination and cooperation

This Commission collaborates particularly with:

- The Presidium, the Permanent Secretariat, and the Provisional World Parliament;
 - The Boundaries and Elections Administration;
 - The Legislative Review Commission;
 - The Press Office.

8. Entry into force

This document enters into force in February 2026 following its approval by the Ratification Commission, the Presidium, and the Permanent Secretariat. It will remain in force until its next update.
